This policy explains how cookies are used on thewidelife.co.uk.

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, which ones this website uses, and how you can control them. It should be read alongside the Privacy Policy at thewidelife.co.uk/privacy-policy.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device — your computer, phone or tablet — when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work, to remember your preferences, and to give site owners information about how their site is being used.

Cookies are not viruses or malware. They cannot access other files on your device or run programmes. They simply store small pieces of information that the website can read when you return.

Similar technologies — including web beacons, pixels and local storage — work in comparable ways. This policy covers all of them.

2. Cookies this website uses

This website uses a small number of cookies, grouped into three categories:

Essential cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function. Without them, parts of the site will not work correctly. They cannot be disabled via the cookie banner.

XSRF-TOKEN	Essential	Cross-site request forgery protection — keeps the site secure	Session
hs	Essential	Wix platform security cookie	Session
svSession	Essential	Identifies unique visitors to the Wix platform	2 years
cookieConsent	Essential	Stores your cookie consent preferences	1 year

Analytics cookies

These cookies help me understand how visitors use the website — which pages are visited, how long people spend on the site, and where traffic comes from. This information is aggregated and anonymised; it does not identify you personally.

These cookies are set only with your consent, via the cookie banner when you first visit the site.

Cookie name	Type	Purpose	Duration
_ga	Analytics (Google)	Distinguishes unique users for Google Analytics	2 years
ga*	Analytics (Google)	Maintains Google Analytics session state	2 years
_gid	Analytics (Google)	Distinguishes users — expires quickly	24 hours
_gat	Analytics (Google)	Throttles request rate to Google Analytics	1 minute

Marketing cookies

The Wide Life does not currently use marketing, advertising or retargeting cookies. If this changes, this policy will be updated and your consent will be sought before any such cookies are set.

Third-party cookies

Some cookies on this site are set by third parties whose services are embedded in the site. These include:
